CONNECTED FOREST™ Xchange (CFX) is a collaborative cloud solution designed to provide visibility and timber security in real-time. CFX also includes mobile trip ticketing, with the option to have paperless exchanges between logging sites and destination mills. CFX is easily deployed and integrated with CFBusiness solution LIMS.

FIBER SUPPLY DATA VISIBILITY

CFX provides contractors with the ability to access log load and piece scale information for all scale site deliveries by mobile phone, tablet or web browser.

Contractor field workers and office administration have real-time access to details such as crew productivity, hauling/cycle times, deliveries and overweights.

CFX provides operational supply chain visibility and cloud-based data collection for streamlining administration and financial tasks.

TIMBER SECURITY

Easily track load trip tickets that do not have a matching weight scale record to monitor and prevent timber security breaches. CFX also captures the geographic location of the source and destination.

DATA IMPORT & EXPORT

Easy import and export of all load data formats necessary for log accounting, contractor settlements, and access to datasets in real-time from any internet-connected device.

MOBILE TRIP TICKETS

Integrated mobile trip ticketing provides loader operators and truck drivers with easy to use mobile applications to capture and upload key trip ticket data (with the option of paperless or paper ticketing) to CFX, improving safety and simplifying scale site receiving and departure steps for drivers.

ANALYSIS & REPORTING

CFX has fully functioning data grids and pivot query tools allowing users to save defined layouts for personal or company-wide use. The dashboard highlights key performance indicators, provides extensive charts for visualization, and facilitates analysis of historical and real-time industry data.

INDUSTRY COLLABORATION

Industry access to secure, real-time supply chain data introduces many opportunities for the forest industry. Data is at the core of operational decision making. Sawmills, pulpmills, forest companies and contractors can now integrate with their partners to efficiently manage daily load transactions and forecast activities.

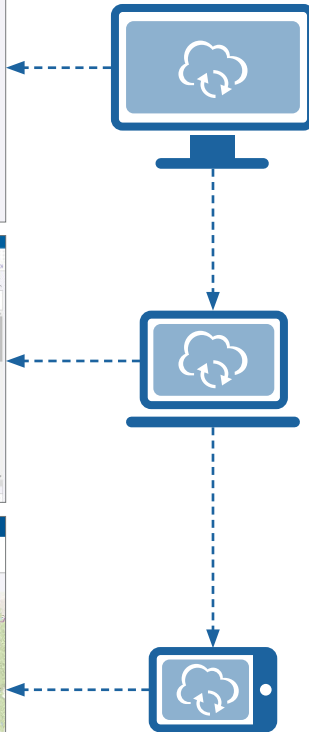
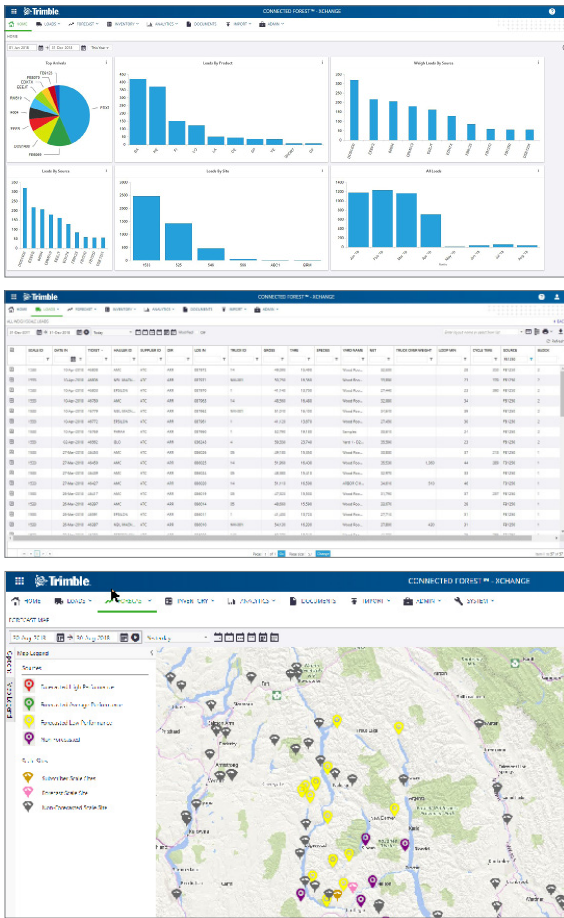

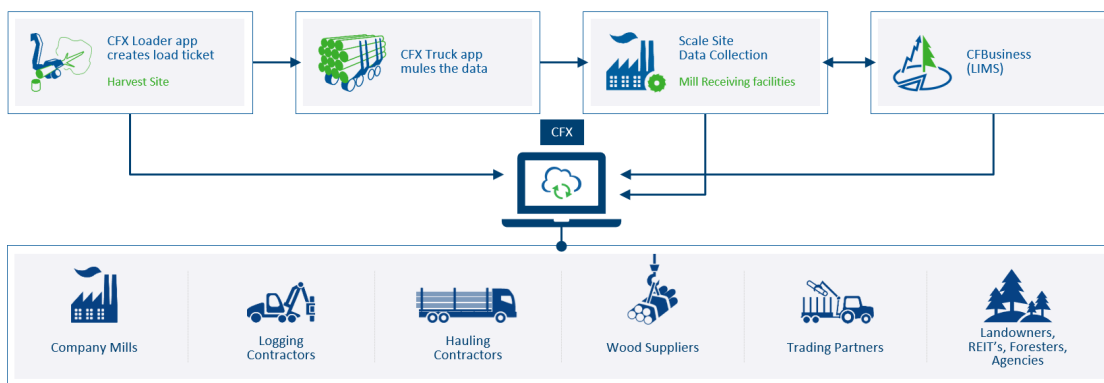
